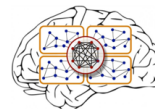

20 and 45 minutes at a time.**

Your brain keeps working **for 10 minutes
after you've stopped learning.**

and creating a more complete picture



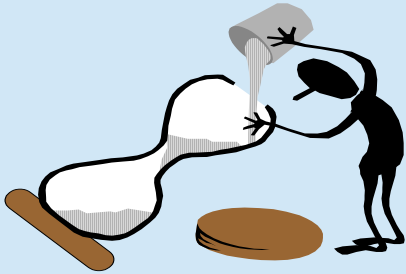

English	<p><u>Non-fiction</u> Reading - retrieval, summary, analysis using TEA/EA1 and comparison</p> <p>Transactional Writing – persuade, argue, explain or advise</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Letter layout and appropriate features • Article layout and appropriate features • Speech layout and appropriate features • Text of a leaflet with appropriate layout and appropriate features • Essay layout and appropriate features

Space it out

Revise a variety of topics,
not one subject all in one go



Organise it

Plan a timetable to check you're doing a spread of topics and subjects.



Be realistic.

Remember sessions should only be for 30 – 40 minutes with 10 minute breaks

A variety of subjects across a day

Review slots

Encourage them to start NOW :

1- 2 sessions on a week night.

3-4 at the weekend.

Build in treats

Discuss it

Build in rewards

Lots of praise
