

When to apply?

- If you plan to take a gap year before going to university, it's best to apply to university while in Year 13 and tell the university you want to defer the start by one year
- Try to have some idea of what you will do on your gap year by the time you apply to university (the university will want to know that you will not be wasting the year)
- You would usually then make the actual arrangements for your gap year during Year 13

Do some research to make a long-list of things you might like to do on a gap year, then find organisations that can help you to achieve it.


