# Applying for Student Finance

- **Tuition fees loan**
  - Paid direct to your university
- **Maintenance loan** (up to £8,430 if not in London)
  - Paid into your bank account
  - 65% available to all: 35% means-tested (eligible if household income is less than £42,000)
- **Grants**
  - Disabled Students' Allowance (including for dyslexia)

# Repayment of your loans

- No repayment until you are earning over £25,000 per year
- You'll repay 9% of your income over £25000 until the loan has been paid-off
  - Eg. If you earn £27,000 per month, your repayments will be £15 per month
- If, after 30 years, the loan has not been paid off, it is cancelled
