- Half-termly assessments
- Trial Exams: January 22-24
June 16-20
February 10-14 (U6th)
- Parents' Consultation Evening: February 6
- Progress Reports: October, February, July

Illness – what to do

If students ...

- ...are ill in the morning and cannot come into college?
= **parent contacts the college**
- ...become ill during the day and need to go home?
= **go to the office**
- ...know in advance that they will be absent? (eg driving test)
= **tell Sixth Form staff and tutor**

What could get in the way of success in the Sixth Form?

- Absence (at least 95% attendance is needed)
- Too much paid work (no more than 10 hours)
- Not working enough between lessons
- **Not accepting support**

How can parents help?

- Provide study space at home
- Help with attendance & punctuality
- Take a look at “review notes” from lessons
- Help with planning revision timetables
- Keep us informed

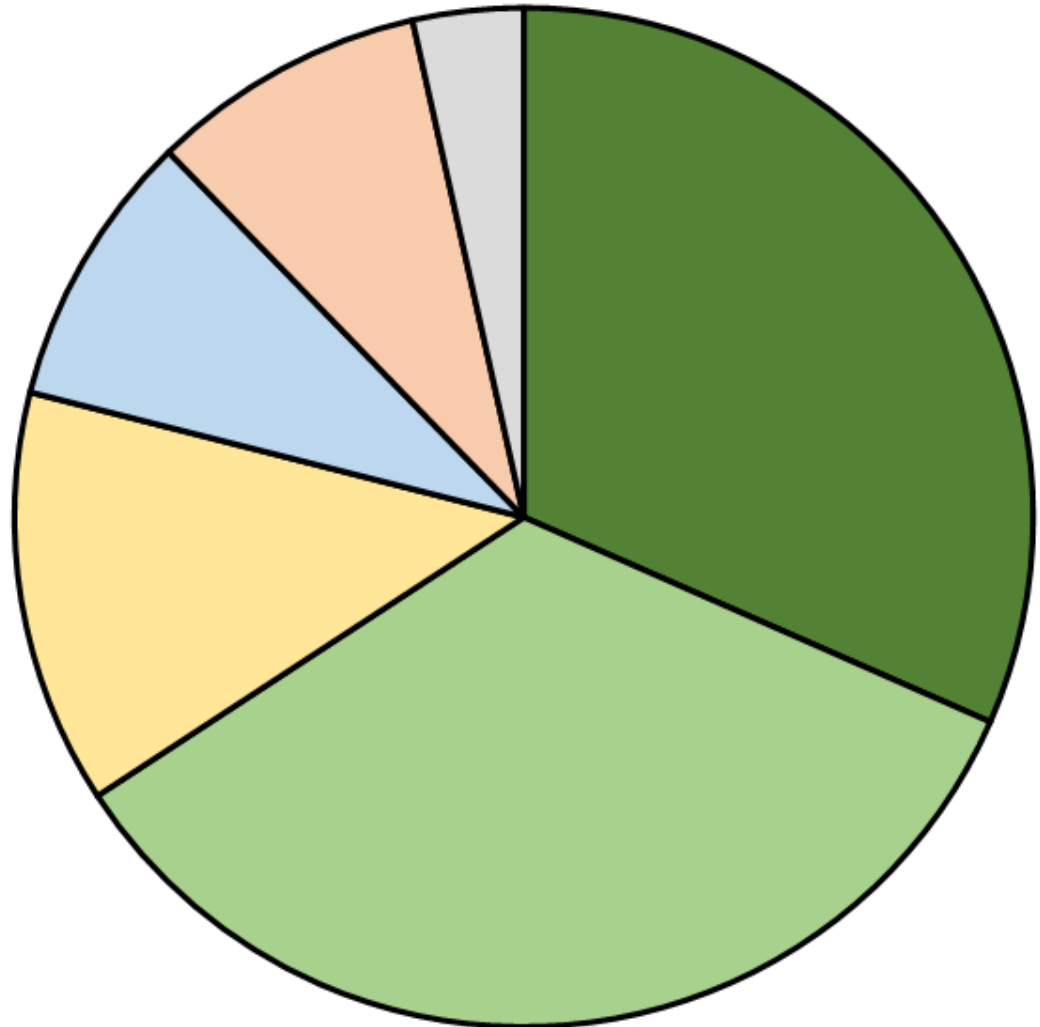
